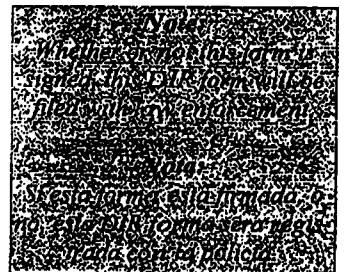

I told him that I just bought gas for the 4-wheeler and if he wanted to take it then he would have to give me the money. John stood there for a few seconds and just looked at me. I wondered at that point if John would come after me. I started walking over towards the car and John came up behind me and pushed me. I fell on the ground. I got up and John slammed me on the ground. John was punching me in the head and in the shoulders. I had my hands up so I could block the punches. I kept trying to get in the car but John kept pushing me down. Finally I got in the car and locked the doors.

He walked over to the car and a couple times he would raise the sledgehammer up as if he was going to smash the windows. At that point I was in fear of my life. John hit my driver's side door with the handle part of the hammer and he kicked my car. Then I saw John grab a gas can from the garage. John poured gas on the house and then he poured it all over the car. The next thing I saw was John standing right in front of the car with a lit match. I saw him light the match and then he stated "You're going down bitch." I didn't think that I was going to get out of the car and I thought that he was going to start it on fire. The match did not stay lit. John went back to the sledgehammer again and had it as he walked around the car. He then walked down the driveway with the sledgehammer and left. I think that John would like to kill me and then I believe he would kill himself.
