FIRST COUNT:

THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, by this indictment, accuses the defendant, BRIAN BALL, of the crime of Offering a False Instrument for Filing in the First Degree, in violation of Section 175.35 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

The defendant, on or about November 18, 2005, in the County of Monroe, State of New York, knowing that a written instrument, to wit: a Greece Police Department Investigative Action Report dated November 18, 2005 under CR#5066106, contained a false statement or false information and with intent to defraud the state or any political subdivision thereof, he offered or presented said written instrument to a public office or public servant, with knowledge or belief that said written instrument would be filed with, registered or recorded in or otherwise become a part of the records of such public office or public servant.

SECOND COUNT:

AND THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, by this indictment, further accuses the defendant, BRIAN BALL, of the crime of Falsifying Business Records in the Second Degree, in violation of Section 175.05, Subdivision 1 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

The defendant, on or about November 18, 2005, in the County of Monroe, State of New York, with intent to defraud, made or caused a false entry in the business record of an enterprise, to wit: a Greece Police Department Investigative Action Report dated November 18, 2005 under CR#5066106.

THIRD COUNT:

AND THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, by this indictment, further accuses the defendant, BRIAN BALL, of the crime of Official Misconduct, in violation of Section 195.00, Subdivision 1 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

The defendant, a public servant, on or about November 18, 2005, with intent to obtain a benefit or deprive another of a benefit, committed an act relating to his office but constituting an unauthorized exercise of his official functions, knowing that such act was unauthorized.

FOURTH COUNT:

AND THE GRAND JURY OF THE COUNTY OF MONROE, by this indictment, further accuses the defendant, BRIAN BALL, of the crime of Official Misconduct, in violation of Section 195.00, Subdivision 2 of the Penal Law of the State of New York, committed as follows:

The defendant, a public servant, on or about November 18, 2005, knowingly refrained from performing a duty which was imposed upon him by law or that was clearly inherent in the nature of his office.
